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
COLD AND FLU SEASON IS COMING

As the leaves start to fall and the air turns crisper, we are reminded that flu season is around the corner. For seniors, staying healthy during the colder months is especially crucial, as the flu can lead to serious complications in older adults. But, with the right precautions, we can significantly reduce their risk of getting sick. People ages 65 and older are more susceptible to complications of the cold and flu due to several factors associated with aging.

Additionally, people with certain chronic conditions like diabetes, heart disease, and lung disease are at a higher risk of developing life-threatening complications from the flu. That is because these health conditions can further compromise the immune function, therefore increasing their vulnerability to illness.

Since flu strains and cold viruses in the environment pose a higher risk, it is crucial to take extra precautions to stay healthy during this time. Flu vaccine clinics are now available, book at reception or online through HOT DOC and at the Reserve and Hillside flu clinic booking sheets are up in the village.

Flu Clinics are scheduled for Tuesday 22nd April at The Reserve and Tuesday 29th April at Hillside Community.



Fees at RFC

The fees at RFC will be increasing as of January 1st 2024. Since Medicare's inception the Government's indexation of Medicare rebates has never kept pace with the rising cost of medical practice. From 2012-2017 almost all MBS rebates were frozen with no indexation.

Since then Medicare rebate increases have been significantly less than inflation.

This year the Medicare rebate was increased by 3.6% whilst our employment costs alone increased by 6.2%.

In order to continue to cover the increasing costs of running a General Practice our policy has always been to charge AMA rates which are independently adjusted each year to cover the costs of running a General Practice.
